## **Legal Career Background**

- hold a Bachelor of Law Degree from International Islamic University Malaysia in year 2001.
- He read law in the chambers of Mr. Megat Abdul Munir of Messrs. Yazli Zain Megat & Murad (therein known as Messrs. Zain Megat & Murad) since October 2001;
  - \* his main areas of exposure were civil litigation works which cover banking litigation, debt recovery, enforcement of the assignment and charge;
  - \* he also was exposed with the various legal matters - like the law of contract, the company's law, land law, labour law or industrial matters.
  - \* Assisted his Master on research work of various levels of civil proceedings and conducted the court cases as well as drafting agreements.

    - \* Company law : winding up proceeding, issuance of notice under section 218 of Companies Act 1960, breach of directors duty, lifting corporate veil, indoor management rule, Injunction application, Specific Performance, Writ of Distress;
    - \* Building contract or the law of construction;
    - \* Execution of the Judgment : bankruptcy proceeding, judgment of debtor summon, writ of seizure and sale, contempt of court;
